*Charter of Incorporation*

Be It Known, That J. D. Haston, George Thomas Haston, Juanita Bolin  
Haston, D. R. Haston and Paul Russell

are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of and style of HASTON CEMETARY TRUST FUND, INC.  
for the purpose of soliciting, collecting and handling trust funds and property  
to be invested and managed by a Board of Directors, the earned in-  
come from which will be used in the unkeep of the Haston Family  
Cemetery, in Van Buren County, Tennessee.

Expulsion shall be the only remedy for the nonpayment of dues by the members, and there shall be no individual liability against the members for corporate debts, but the entire corporate property shall be liable for the claims of creditors.

We, the undersigned, the incorporators above mentioned, hereby apply to the State of Tennessee for a charter of incorporation for the purposes declared in the foregoing instrument.

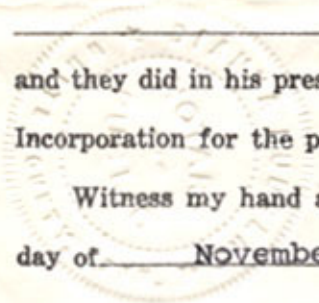
